EPINEPHRINE ADMINISTRATION PROTOCOL

An insect sting allergy most often causes a state of shock.

A food allergy most often causes respiratory distress

CRITERIA

Recent contact with a causal agent (within the past four + hours).

One of the two following situations is present:

- Presence of respiratory distress.
- Circulatory failure.

or

At least **two** of the following four clinical signs are present:

- Hives or angioedema;
- Respiratory difficulty;
- Circulatory failure
- Gastrointestinal symptoms

INJECTION OF EPINEPHRINE



CALL 911

In case of deterioration : re-administer epinephrine every 5 minutes.

If no improvement: repeat every 10 minutes.

If improvement but criteria still present: repeat every 10 minutes.
