

# EPINEPHRINE ADMINISTRATION PROTOCOL

**An insect sting allergy  
most often causes a  
state of shock.**

**A food allergy most  
often causes  
respiratory distress**

## CRITERIA

Recent contact with a causal agent (within the past four hours).



**One** of the two following situations is present:

- Presence of respiratory distress.
- Circulatory failure.

**or**

At least **two** of the following four clinical signs are present:

- Hives or angioedema;
- Respiratory difficulty;
- Circulatory failure
- Gastrointestinal symptoms

INJECTION OF  
EPINEPHRINE



CALL 911

**In case of deterioration :** re-administer epinephrine every 5 minutes.

**If no improvement:** repeat every 10 minutes.

**If improvement but criteria still present:** repeat every 10 minutes.
